

Reindeer Food for Christmas

This is a great idea for your children to leave food for the Santa's reindeers on Christmas Eve

You will need:

- Brown paper bag
- A piece of red or green card for antlers
- Red bobble for the nose
- Porridge oats or other dry food for the reindeer
- Felt tip pen to draw eyes.

Instructions

1. Fold the bag in half, then fold again one third of the way down.
2. Bring the 2 corners together and fold to make a triangular nose
3. Cut out 2 antlers and stick on the back of the bag
4. Stick the red bobble on the point of the triangle to make the nose
5. Draw the eyes and the eyebrows on your reindeer.
6. Open the bag and put some oats (or other dry food) into the bag
7. On a piece of paper type or write the following:

Reindeer Food

On the night before Christmas,
Before you go to bed,
Open this bag and sprinkle the food
Onto a plate and place on the lawn for
Santa's reindeers

When you wake up Christmas morning
Look to see if it has been eaten!

Ensure that the paper is small enough to be cut out and stuck on the front of the paper bag.
